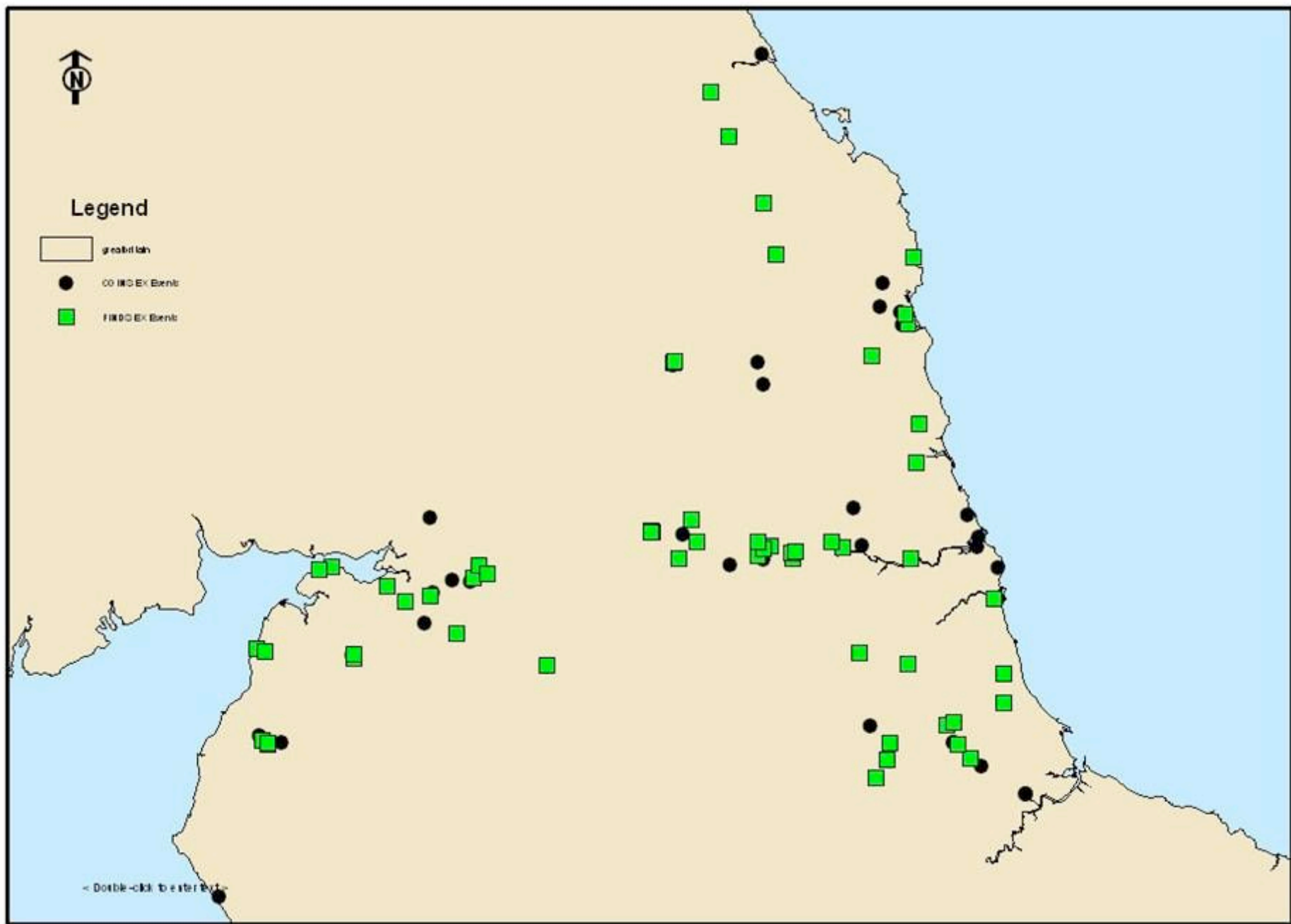

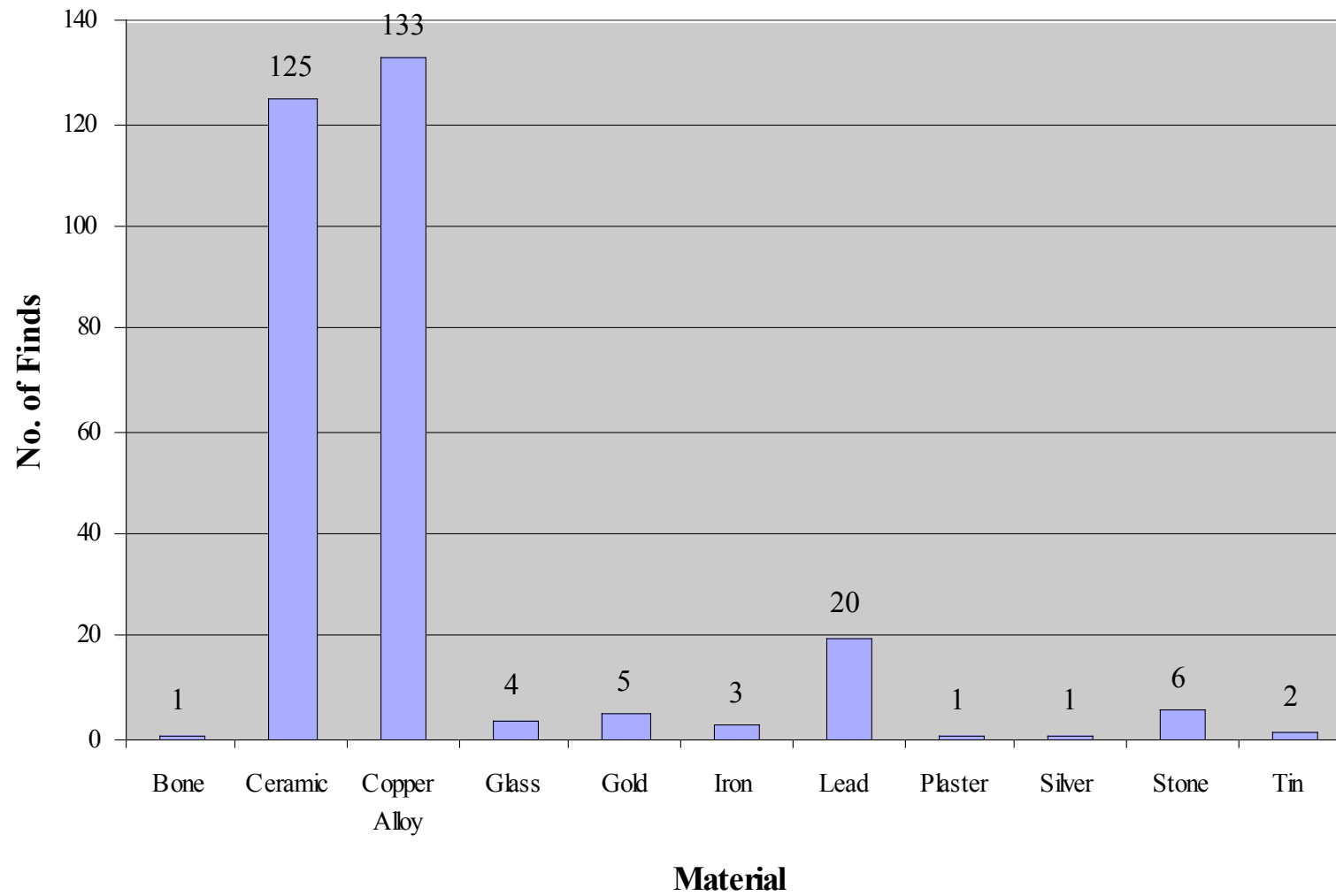




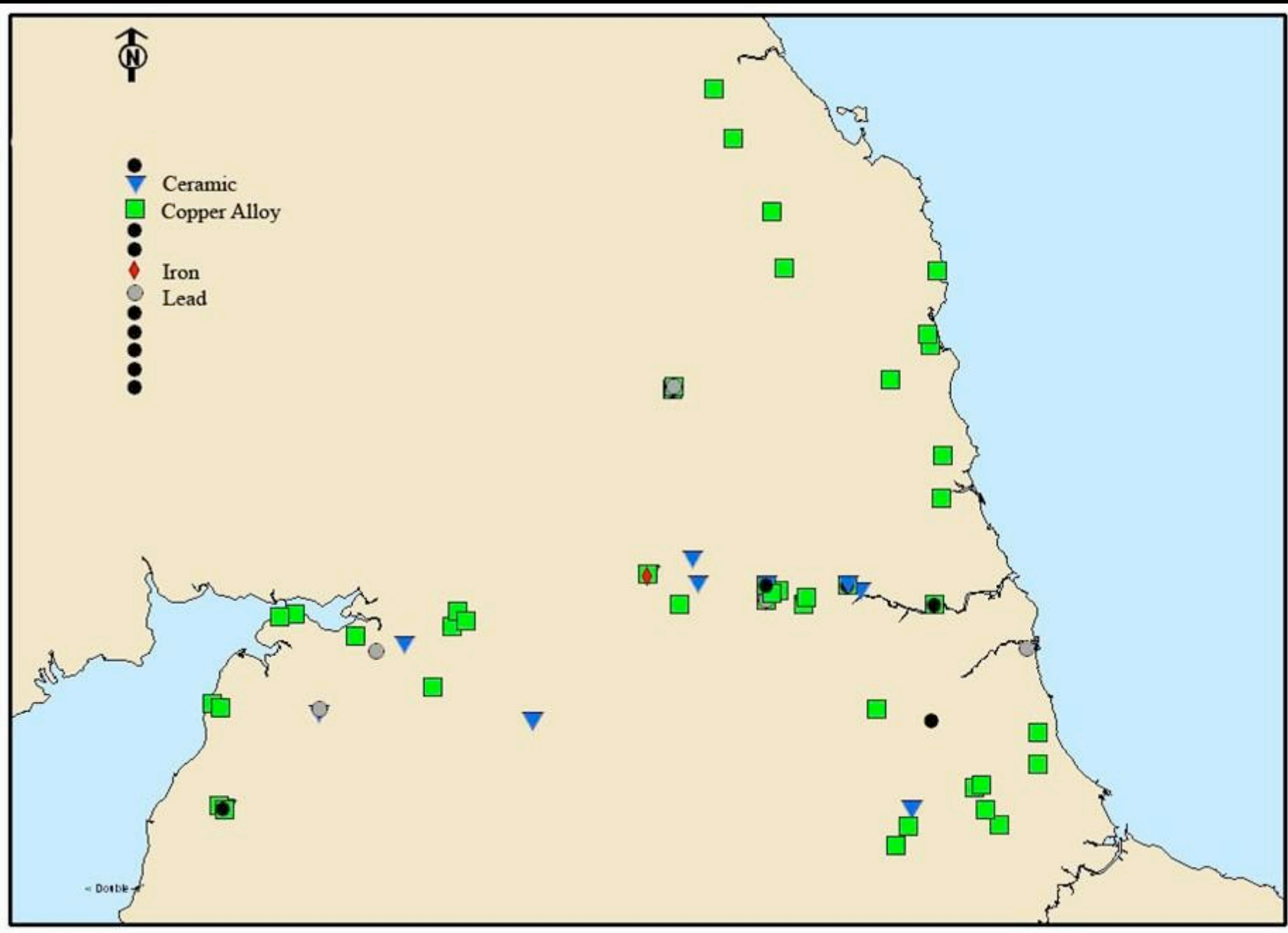
# Distribution of Artefacts (green squares) and Coins (black circles)



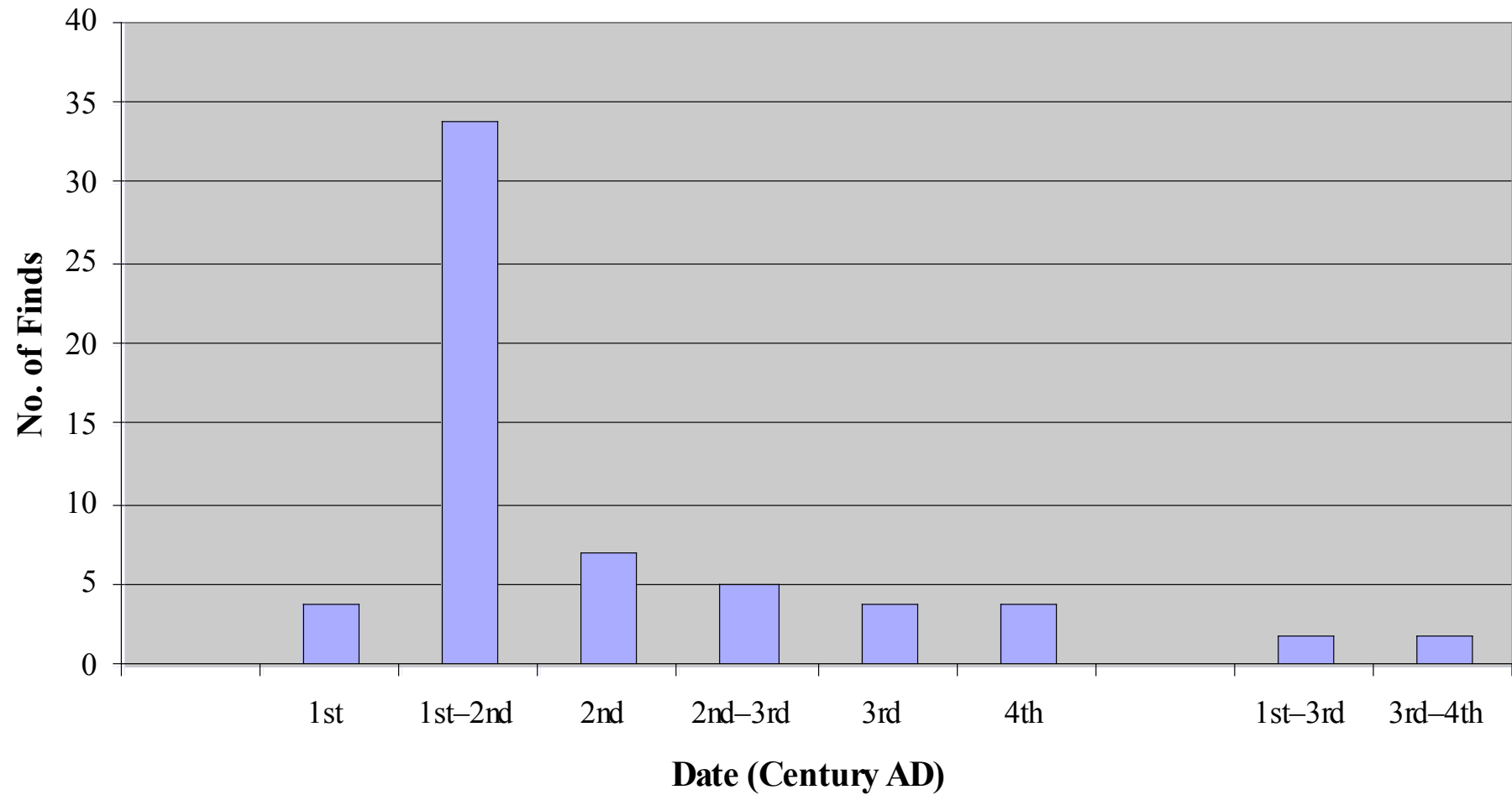
## Artefacts: Primary Material



# Artefact Distribution by Material

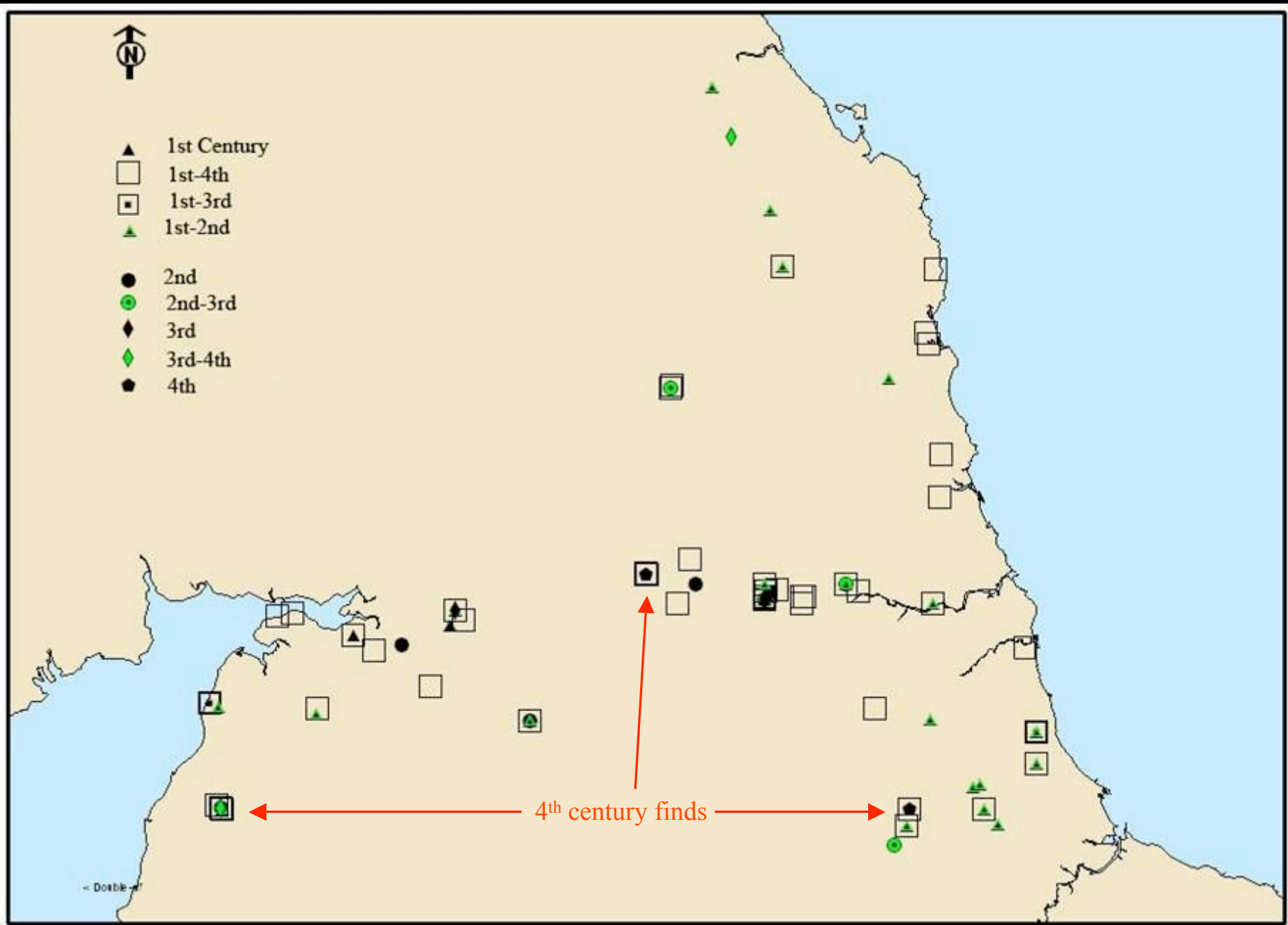


## Artefacts: Date Distribution

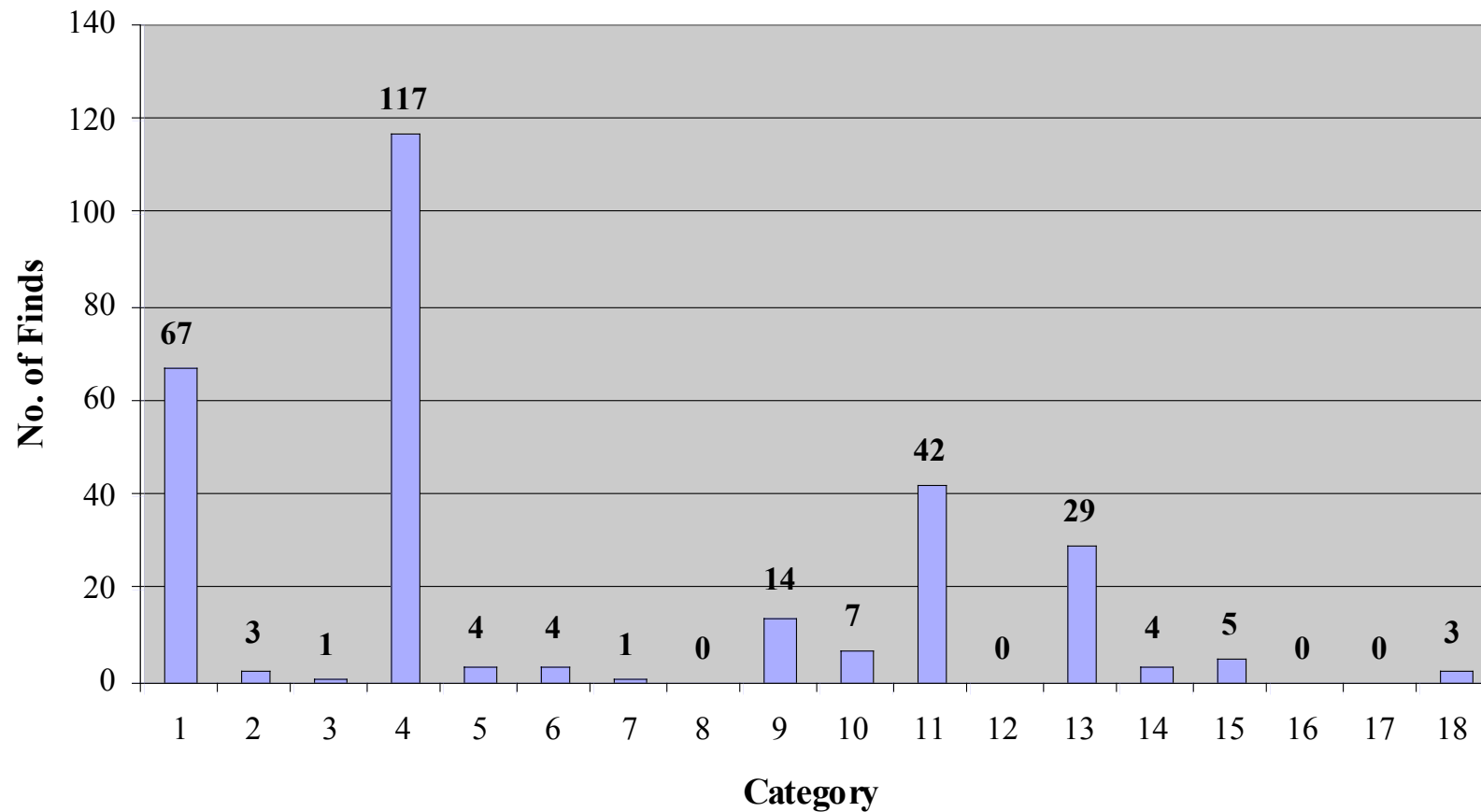

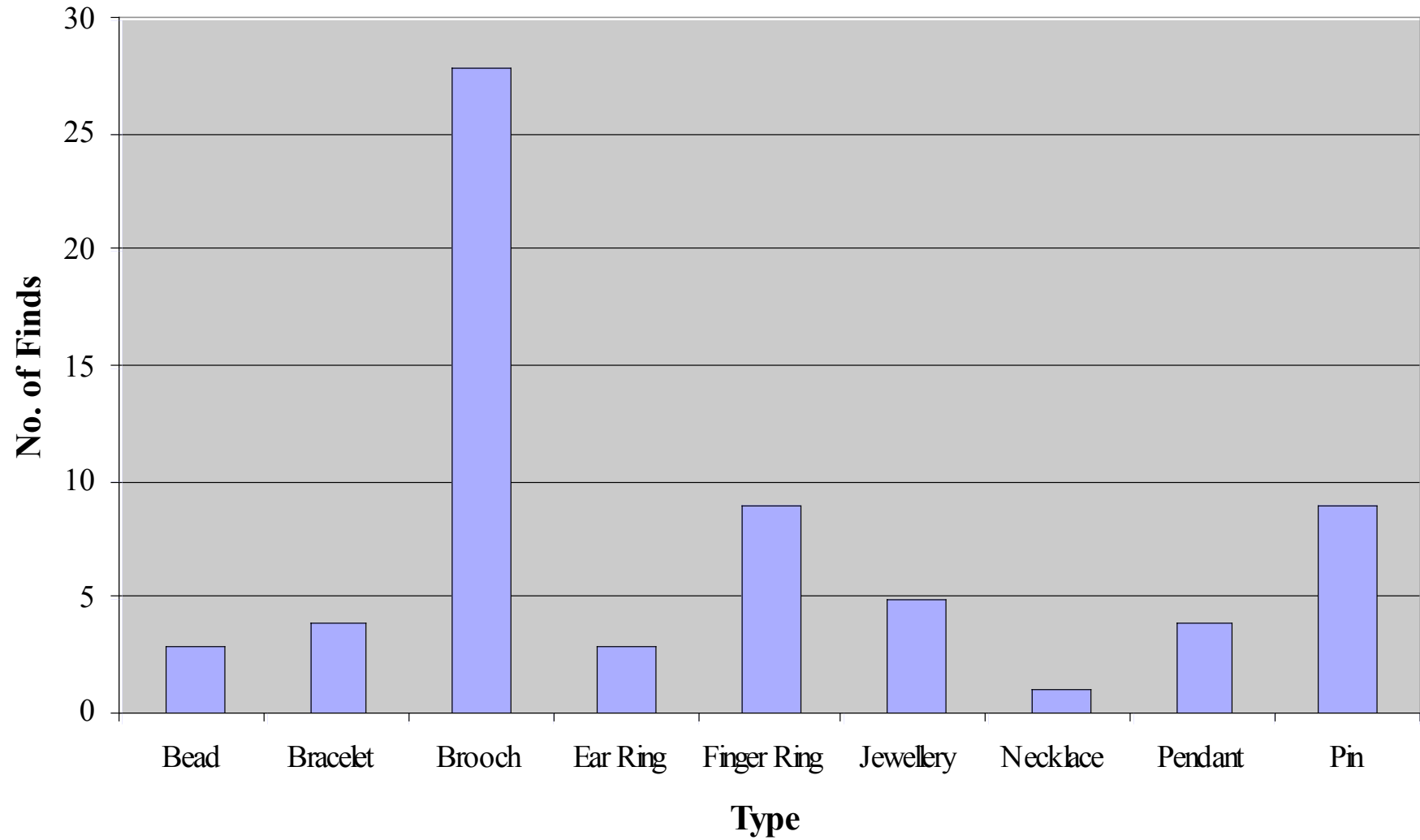

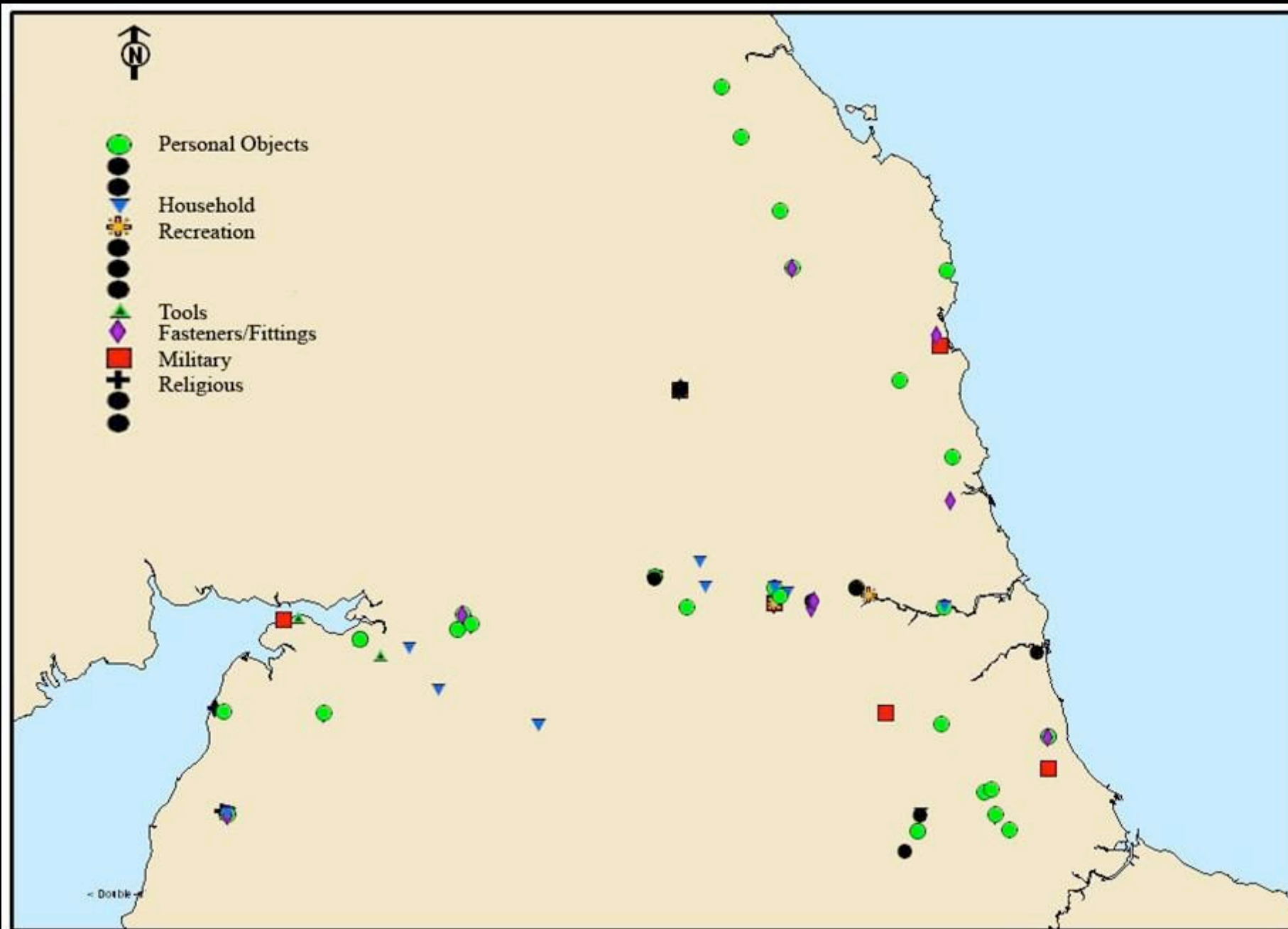

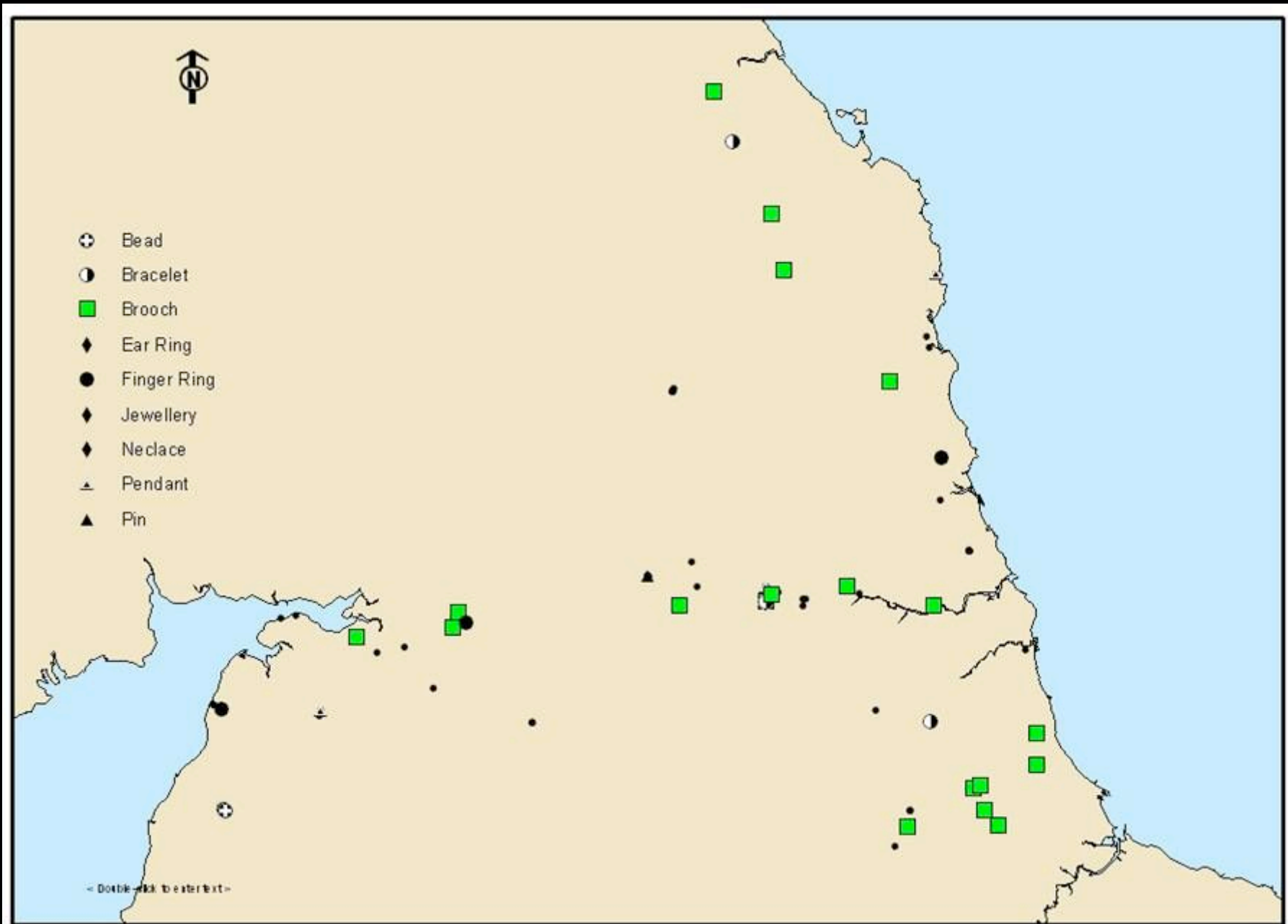
## Personal Ornaments by Type



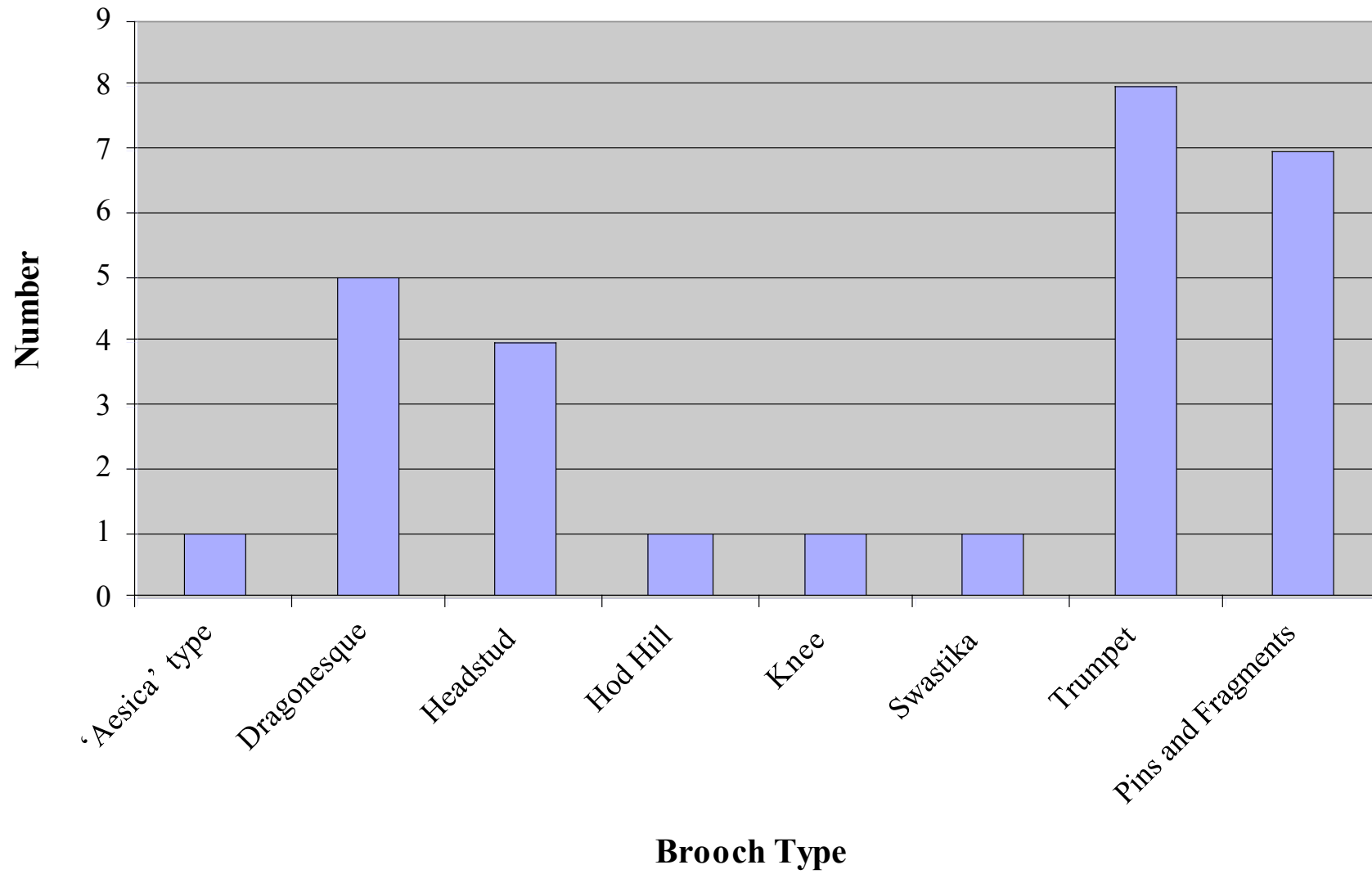
# Artefact Distribution by Category



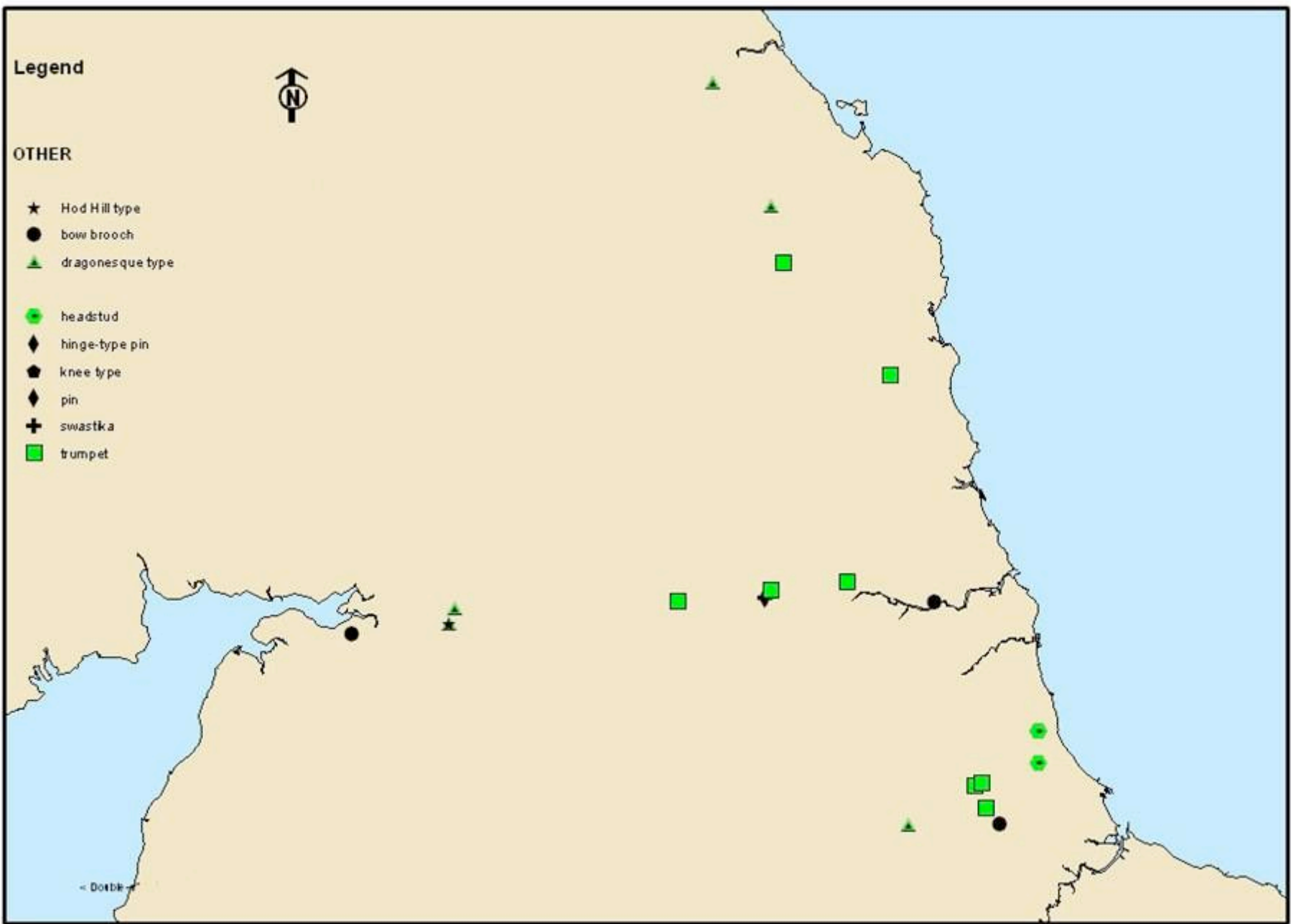
# Personal Ornament Distribution compared to other artefacts (small black dots)



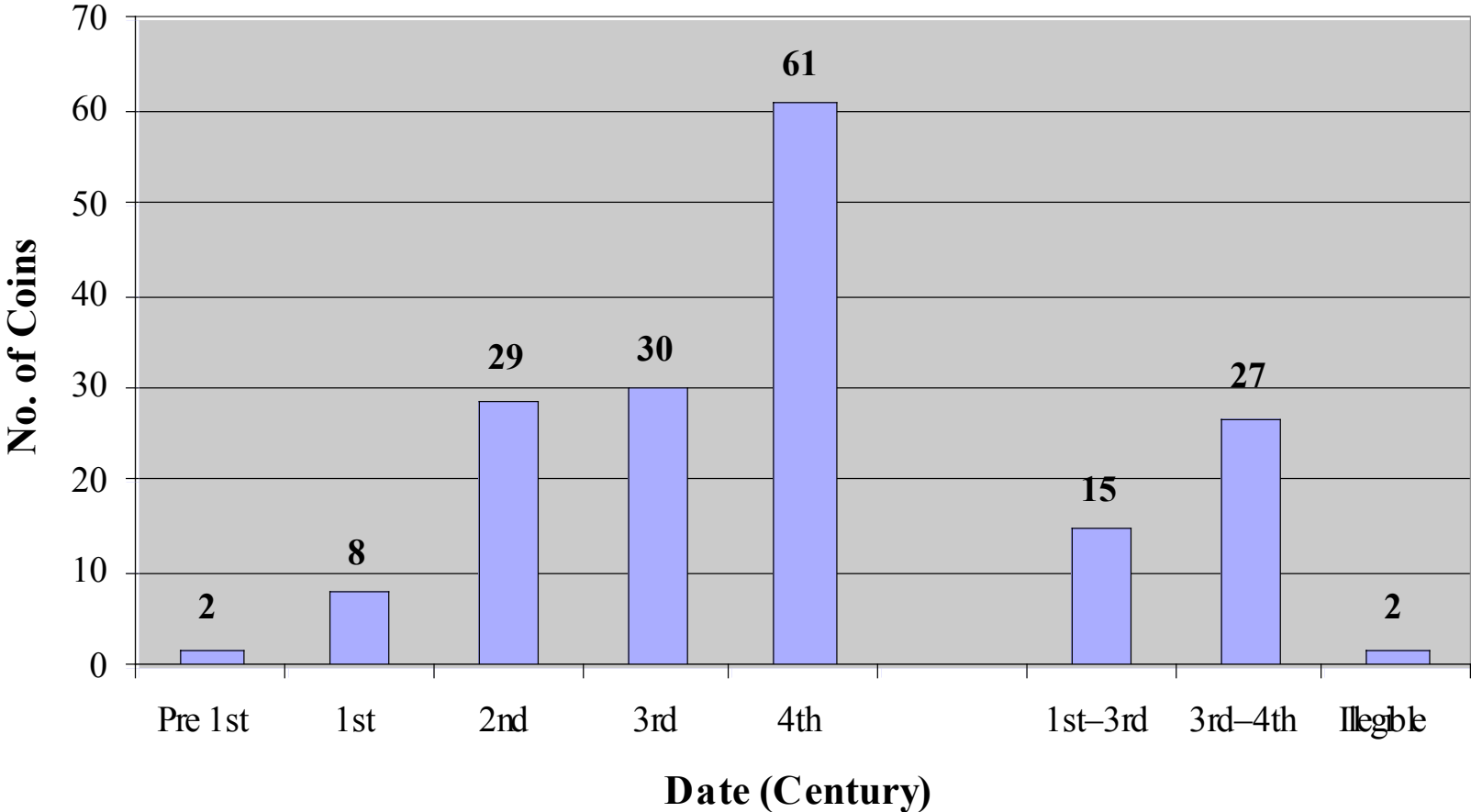
## Brooches by Type



# Brooch Distribution by Type

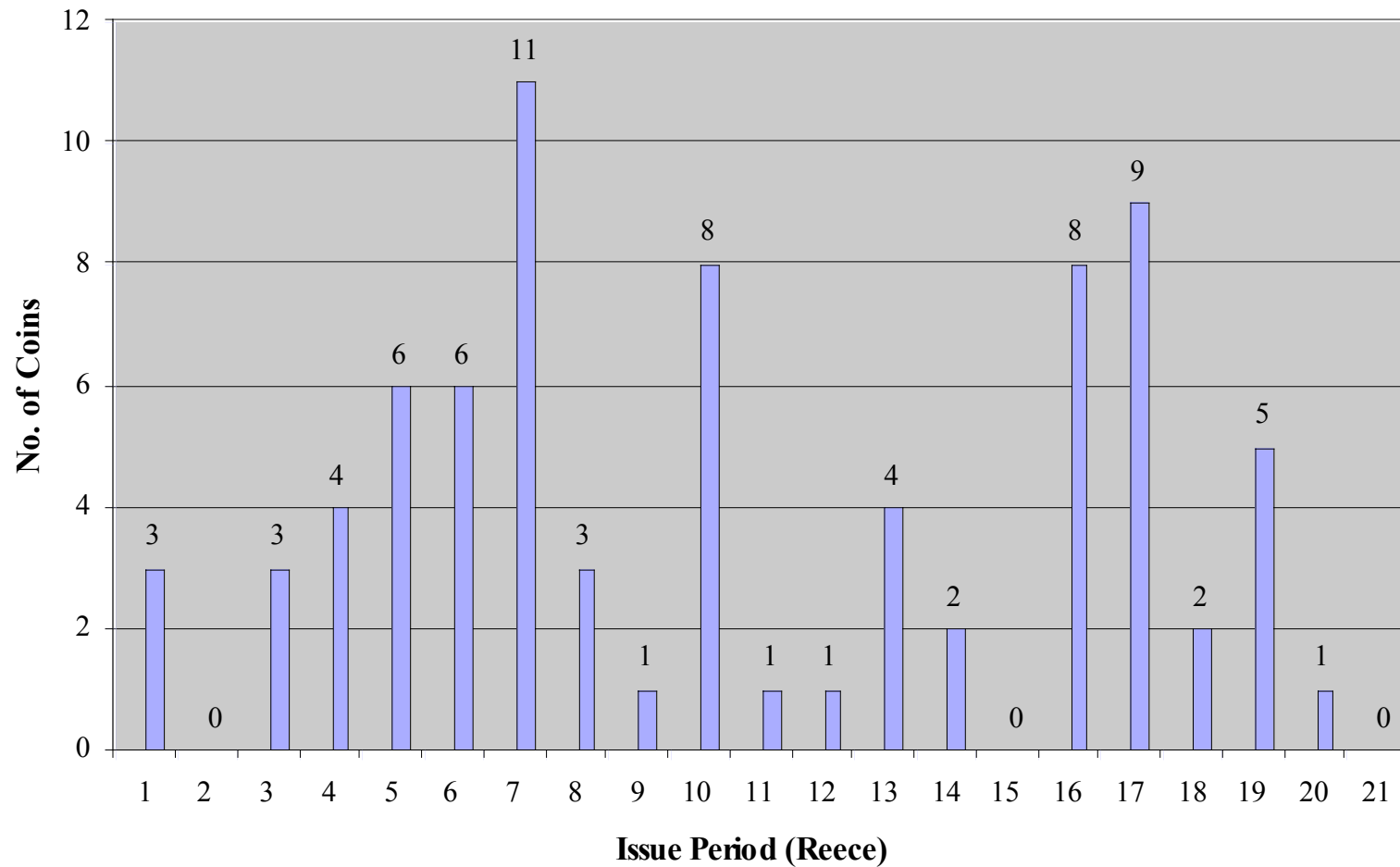

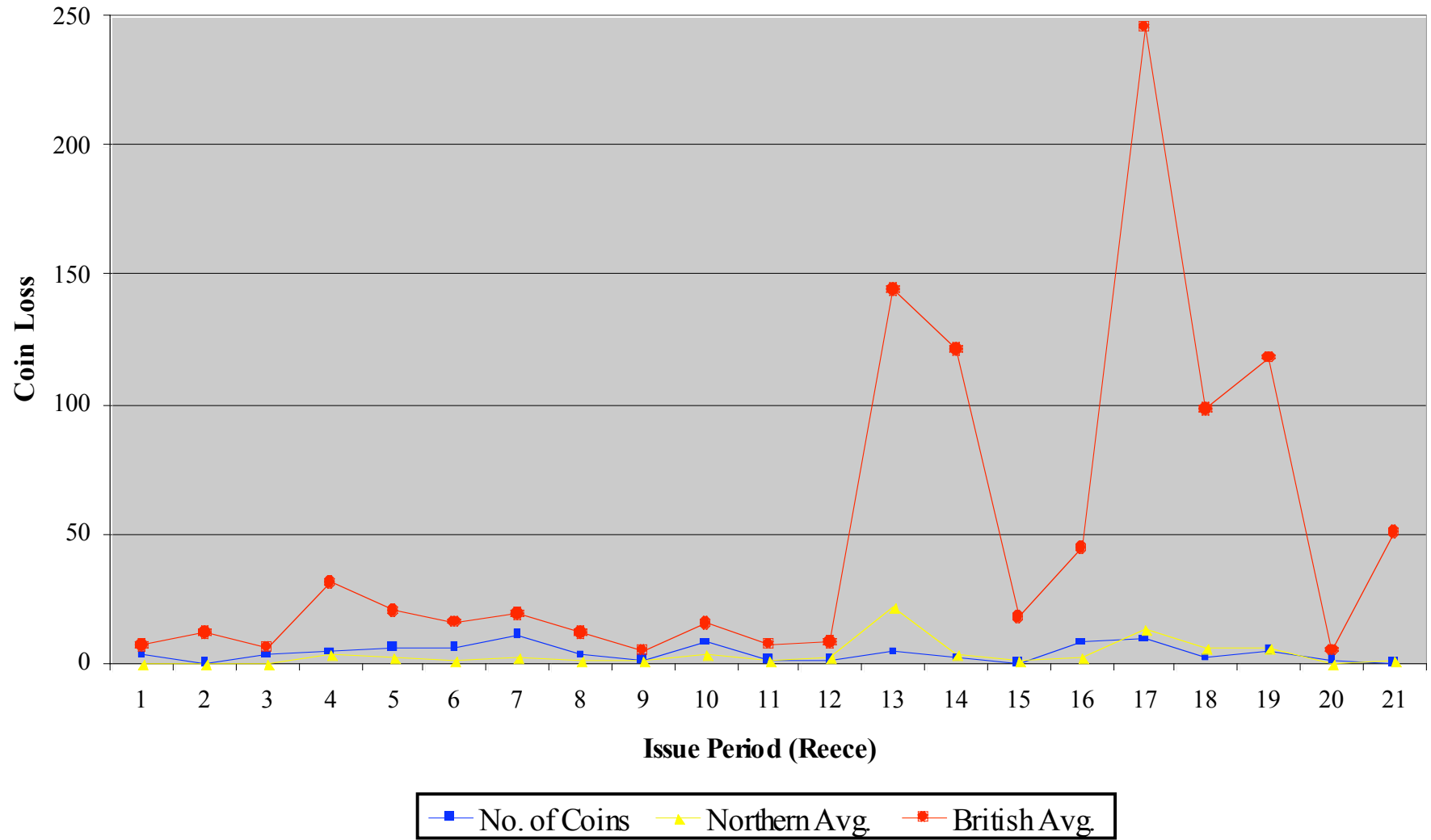

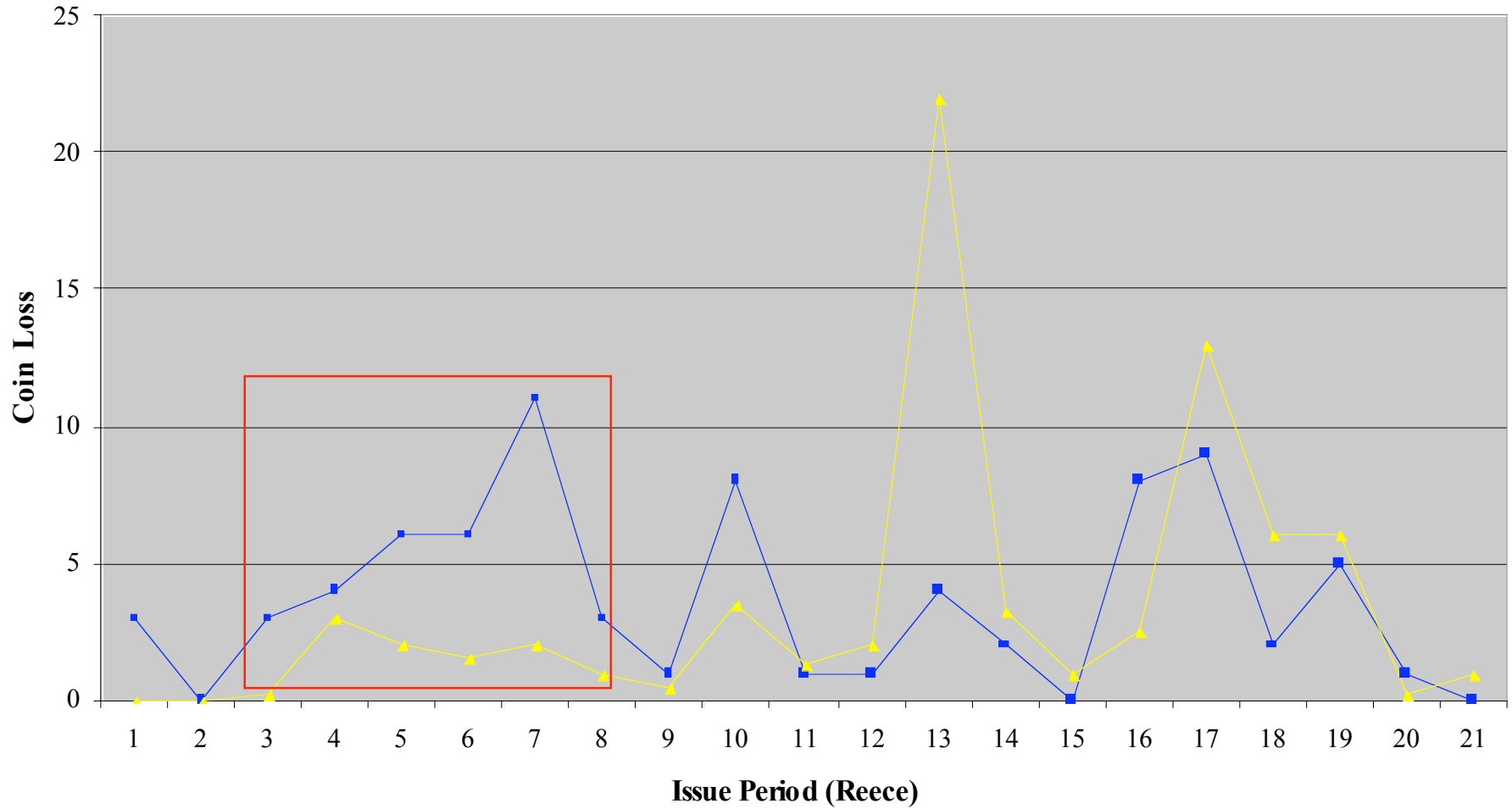

## Coin Loss Compared



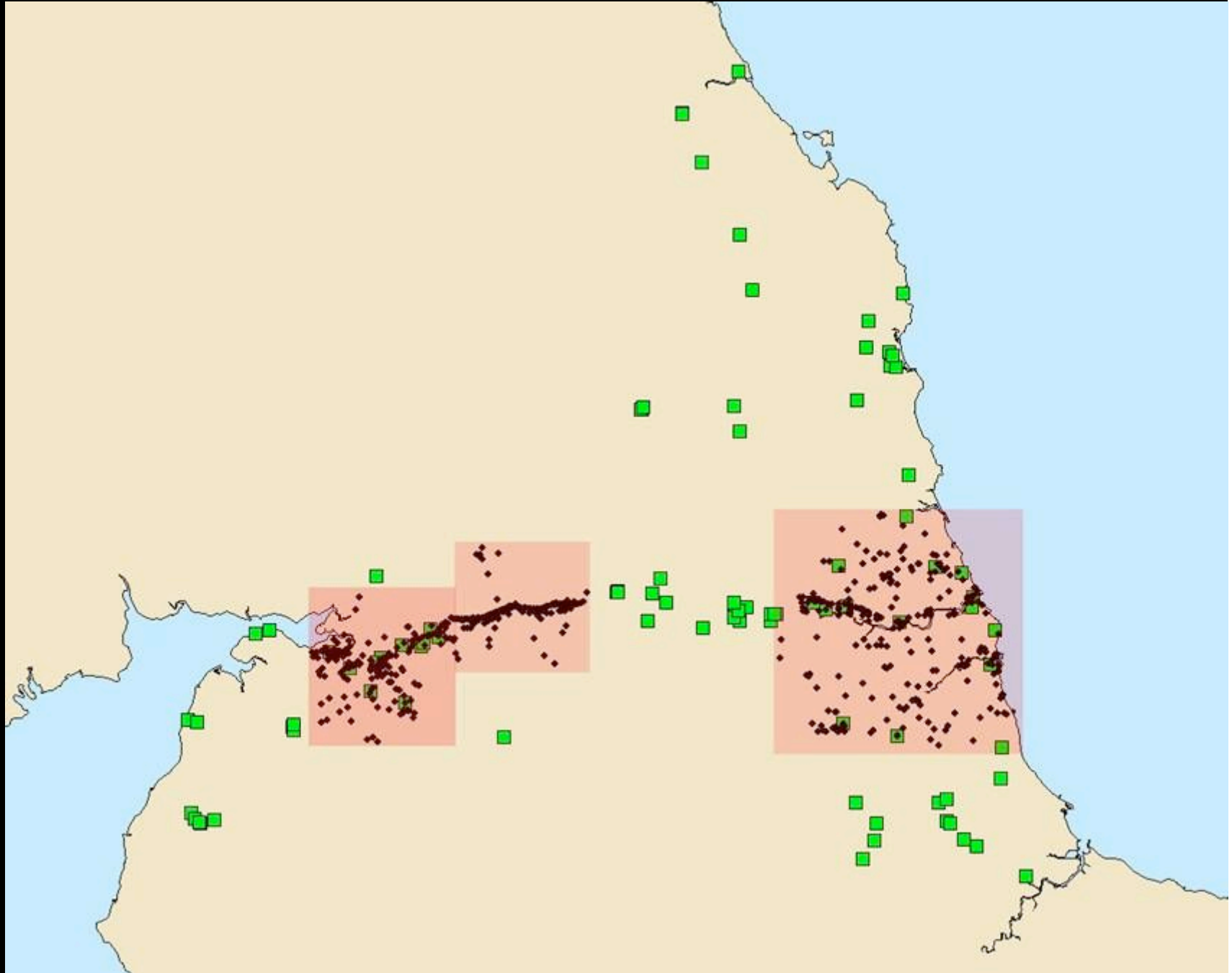

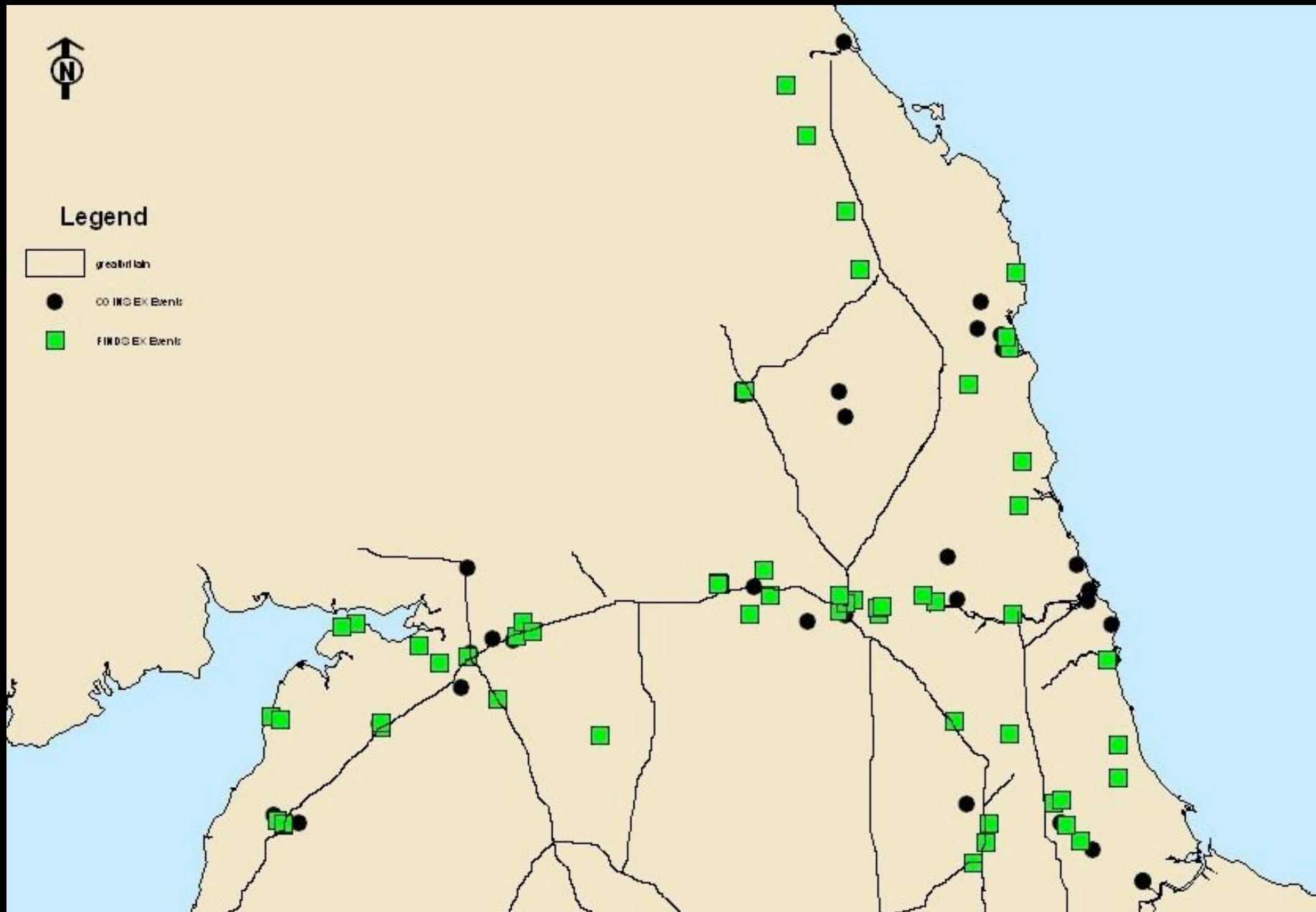
—■— No. of Coins —▲— Northern Avg
