An incomplete cast copper alloy spur dating from the post-medieval period, c. AD 1500-1700. The item comprises the broken terminal end of one spur arm. The arm is oval in cross-section with two loops in a figure of eight arrangement at the terminal which is joined to the centre of the arm. There is a bar at the end of the spur arm where it joins the loop section extending beyond the arm on both sides. The item is a dark green and brown colour.

Measurements :- Length 26.31mm, Width (arm) 5.61mm, Thickness (arm) 2.41mm, - Loops 12.84mm x 9.15, Weight 2.9g
