Silver finger ring of Modern, nineteenth century date (AD 1800 - AD 1900). Diameter 17mm, width of hoop 5mm, thickness of hoop 0.4mm. Weight 0.79g.

The ring is made from a stamped strip joined with solder to form a hoop. The exterior surface of the hoop is decorated with repetitive and closely aligned transverse ribs. Overlying the ribbing are two further decorative elements, each occupying about half the circumference of the hoop. In one half are seven flower motifs, each consisting of a central pellet within a circle of five equally spaced and similar pellets. The flowers are alternately branched in racemed form along a curvilinear tendril. An interruption to the continuity of this design signifies the location of the soldered join. The other half of the hoop has the inscription in serifed capital letters:

FORGET ME NOT

The inscription is framed within a rectangular border of repetitive motifs in the form of small heart-shaped leaves. There is no evidence for a hallmark on the inner surface of the hoop. The ring is in good condition and is slightly worn.

A gold finger ring with the same inscription and similar type-face with a transverse ribbed ground has been recorded from Covehithe Parish, Suffolk, see Portable Antiquities Scheme find: SF-AF0664.
