There is a wire line inside the beaded border between the field and the legend on both faces. Obverse features bust of Elizabeth I facing west without Rose, Legend around ELIZABETH DG AN.FR.D REGINA. Reverse has a square shield on long cross fourchee, no date, legend around POSVI DEV ADIVTOREM MEV. The coin weighs 1.6g and is 22.92mm in diameter.
