Incomplete copper alloy fantail variant brooch. The brooch has semi-cylindrical wings in cross-section and is missing its spring. There is a rearward hook in the centre at the top. The bow is short and arched and the foot is in the form of a fantail. The brooch has a moulded band running the entire vertical length in the centre. On the bow this moulding is raised and decorated with two crosses between two double incised lines. On the foot this moulding splits into two raised lines.
