Copper alloy Medieval french jetton, struck in Tournai, dating 1461-1497. The jetton is in good condition, however the reverse legend is unclear. Similar to Mitchener 601-601. The obverse legend reads VIVE LE ROI VIVE LE ROI. The reverse legend is unclear. Mitchener does not have a direct parallel for this jetton. The obverse legend of this jetton does not feature on the 'three circles' of Tournai jettons in Mitchener, however it is found on similar jettons with lis within a lozenge, rather than individual circles.
