

FINGER RING

Gold posy ring shaped like a belt or garter, the moulded decoration shows a double-looped buckle with the tip of the belt wrapped around the main body of the strap to form a loose knot. Four cross moline shaped hole reinforces are shown in the strap after the buckle while the main decoration of the belt is ribbed. Inside the loop is engraved TIME . TRIETH . TRVTH.

Notes:

In the recesses around the buckle and forward element of the strap are the remains of black enamel. Date 17th century. This artefact was reported under the 1996 Treasure Act
