

# FINGER RING

**Unique ID:** BUC-8A2E64

Object type certainty: Certain

A complete gold ring with d-shaped section, inscribed inside 'GOD ABOVE JOYNED US IN LOVE', with makers mark IB (?) in a rectangle with rounded corners. The mark is not identifiable in any standard sources and so it is not possible to confirm that this ring is more than 300 years old.

## Notes:

The ring cannot be securely dated to pre-1709, it therefore falls outside the provisions of the Treasure Act 1996.
