Cast lead circular uniface token. The token has a raised design of the capital letters I.D with a pellet between on one side, the other side is blank. It is 16.2mm in diameter, 1.9mm thick and weighs 3.42 grams. Lead tokens had a wide variety of uses and were made locally, they are therefore hard to date precisely but those with initials are thought to be Post Medieval in date (1500-1850 AD).
