

STRAP FITTING

Unique ID: LVPL2295

Object type certainty: Certain

Slightly trapezoidal with three moulded knobs at one short edge and a projecting knob at the opposite short edge. Pierced eight times including a central lozenge shaped hole. A dome headed copper rivet remains in one of the holes. At the mid-point on the back are two oval lugs at right angles to the body of the object, one on either of the long edges.

Notes:

Function uncertain. Possibly a strap end or a clasp. It is assumed that two other holes were used for rivets and that the lugs supported a spindle.
