A copper-alloy jetton of Post-medieval date. Rose and orb type of Hanns Krauwinckel II, dating to 1586-1613, and struck in Nuremberg. As Mitchiner (1988), p. 436, no. 1504. The jetton is slightly bent. The diameter is 21.96mm and it weighs 1.35g.
