Medieval copper alloy finger-joint cover with two rivet holes from a plate armour gauntlet, an arched plate with a central pointed oval boss set lengthwise. Engraved decoration along sides comprises a double-line chevron. One side has been pushed inwards and has lost one corner. Length 24.5mm. Estimated width 27mm. Height 19mm. Two other examples have been recorded in Norfolk, from the same parish as the present piece (HER 57220, NMS-16B0F3) and Warham (HER 29188). Such objects were current in the period c.1350 - c.1430 (Griffiths. N. in Biddle 1990, 1084-5, fig. 349; Ottaway and Rogers 2002, 2970, fig. 1533, nos. 12932-3).
