Hinging around the frame is a separately cast copper-alloy pin. This is rectangular in form and section, tapering to a rounded tip, with oval loop and single transverse grip at juncture of loop and shaft. The entire object measures 38.42mm in diameter, 3.96mm in thickness and 14.10g in weight. It is of Medieval date, c.14th-15th centuries AD.
