There are no marks on the surviving part of the bodkin, which is cracked and slightly distorted along the whole length. Surviving length 86mm. Maximum surviving width 4mm. Maximum surviving thickness 2mm. Weight 2.9g. Many similar examples have been recorded including NMS-144545 and WAW-8B5CB3. Circa 17<sup>th</sup> century.
