A complete flint worked flake of Mesolithic date (9000-3450BC). The lithic is sub-ovate in plan and concaveo-convex in section. The dorsal surface contains 4 predominant negative scars with corresponding arises. The proximal and right hand edges have been abruptly blunted while the distal and left hand edges show short, parallel, semi abrupt retouch. The ventral surface is predominantly smooth and concave. The lithic retains no cortex and is therefore a tertiary flake.

The flint is a cream in colour with white inclusions.
