The weight is sub-conical with a single cast hole set off centre (diameter 9.3mm). The external edges are slightly faceted. The weight is a mid grey colour with an abraded slight dusty surface patina.

The weight measures 16.1mm height, 24.2mm length, is 28.4mm width; it weighs 46.09 grams.
