An incomplete cast copper alloy zoomorphic object, possibly an incomplete vessel mount or related object dating to the Roman period. The mount has been moulded on the outer face in the shape of a snake's head and has a cusped or concave reverse, possibly to fit the decoration to a vessel or other curved object. The object consists of a cylindrical lug at the top, through which a cylindrical aperture runs; below this, the snake's head is divided into two symmetrical halves by means of a deep central groove running from the mouth to the back of its head. On each side, there is a domed irregularly shaped segment indicating the face, cheek and snout of the snake, with lightly visible incised lentoid eyes near to the top of the head at the side. In between the eyes of the snake, a series of three or possibly four raised diagonal lines emanate from the central groove and this mirrors a more regularly spaced set of diagonal raised lines covering the outer surface of the cylindrical bar mentioned above. The underside of the head is concaved and plain. The entire object has a dark green patina, with areas around the edges of damage and lighter corrosion. The mount measures 29.1mm long, 23.7mm wide, 7.1mm thick and weighs 20.08 grams.

Although a parallel for this object has not been identified, the similarity of the decorative style to Roman snake-headed rings is clear.
