A Medieval silver cut halfpenny of Henry III (AD 1216-1272), dating to AD 1251-1272. Voided long cross penny of class 5g - i, minted in London. Uncertain moneyer. North (1994: 227), nos. 997-999.

Although there is no surviving detail to definitively separate between the above groups, this coin is probably class 5g given that the workmanship does not appear crude enough for class 5h-i.
