Medieval copper alloy buckle, 28mm long and 19mm wide with a weight of 3.88grams. The object is D shaped in form and rectangular in cross section. It has slightly bowed sides and terminates in a collared knob. Its flat edge is slightly recessed. Stirrup shaped buckle such as this are illustrated in the Meol's report and dated to 350-1400 (Griffiths et al. 2007, 94, no.622ff).
