Incomplete post-medieval copper alloy strap fitting, the male or toggle part of a clasp with two rivet holes, one containing remains of an iron rivet, for use with a chatelaine or similar. A small part of the end opposite to the spigot is missing. Very similar to Read 2008 nos. 753-4. Objects such as this are too flimsy to have been used on sword belts (de Reuck 2005). Extant length 43mm. Width 16.5mm. Mid 16th to mid 17th century.
