Copper alloy buckle. Cast single looped buckle frame with a pointed and grooved lip and a narrowed and offset strap bar. A rectangular slotted plate with concave inner ends is looped around the frame and a cast pin with stepped base protrudes through the slot. A rivet of burred head diameter 2.3mm and length 3.2mm passes through the inner ends of the plate, possibly preserving fibrous traces of textile. Suggested date: Late Medieval, 1350-1450.
