A medieval silver annular brooch dating to the period AD 1200 - 1400. The brooch has a projection in the form of a pair of praying hands. The frame has a low triangular section. The frame has a recessed bar for the missing pin, and two flat platforms each with a raised saltire. VI has been scratched into the surface of the frame in varying arrangements, this is post production and therefore perhaps a personal inscription.

#### Notes:

A good comparison and similar artefact is SUR-7A5C46, found in Codford, Wiltshire.

This object contains more than 10% precious metal and is over 300 years old. Consequently, in terms of age and precious metal content, the object qualifies as potential Treasure under the stipulations of the *Treasure Act 1996*.
