The attachment edge is decorated with a repoussé cabled border below which the face of the strap-end is bordered by a rectangular repoussé cabled frame, within which there is an engraved and pecked curvilinear figure reserved on a field of rocker arm. Width 40mm. Length 27mm, with hook, 40mm. 15th century.
