# **BROOCH**

Roman brooch of Colchester derivative, Polden Hill (Mackreth 2011, Part 3, Group 4, flat wing ends type), c.f. Mackreth Type 4.i. Plate 47, AD c. 80-240. The copper alloy brooch has a semi-cylindrical wings decorated with a vertical groove at the outer terminals. Both upper edges of the wings show are incomplete. The axis bar, spring and pin are all missing. At the centre of the upper edge of the wings there is a trace of an integral hook. The bowhead is hump-like in profile and is decorated with a moulding on either side. The head is undecorated but from the bow there is a vertical ridge which continues down the bow and has fine chevrons within it. Either side of the ridge there is a column of high-relief obliquely angled pairs of ridges which are similar to lentoids. The bow is broken below the mid point and is not recent. On the reverse of the bow there is a trace of a catchplate which starts below the wings. The bow is oval in section.

The surface of the brooch has a well-developed grey-green patina.

It measures 27.28mm in length, 18.39mm in width, and weighs 7.02g.

The brooch is a Polden Hill type, Bayley and Butcher (2004:160) comment that the distribution of Polden Hill brooches are concentrated in the West Midlands and suggest they date to AD 80 to 120. Mackreth (2011) classifies this type as a Type 4i.
