An incomplete copper-alloy probable vessel handle probably of Post-Medieval date, c.AD 1500-1900. The handle is probably from a tankard and consists of a sub-rectangular strip, wide at one end and tapering gradually towards the other end, shaped into a roughly D-shaped curve. The wider end of the bar is bent inwards at an angle. An inset projecting bar protrudes from the wider end and terminates in a worn break. From the uppermost point of the wider end is a projecting zoomorphic horse head. A thin neck with a grooved and crested mane curves outwards and meets a drop shaped head with incised grooves for eyes, mouth, and nose. Pointed ears project upwards from the top of the head. Near the base of the handle is a V shaped protruding knop, possibly a thumb rest. Fine incised lines running all over the horse head terminal represent fur. Three pairs of incised lines form a chevron pattern down the outer surface of the handle, between the horse head terminal and the V shaped knop. The handle is otherwise undecorated.

The metal has a black patina and is worn. The handle is 58.3mm long, 9.5mm wide, 5.0mm thick, and weighs 21.2g.
