This single element is circular in plan, convex at the front and concave at the rear. It has a soldered silver wire attachment loop at the rear. At the front there a flower head, possibly a rose with four main petals alternately with four smaller petals or calyx. The front is very worn.

Diameter: 15.7mm; height including loop: 6.0mm diameter of wire: 1.4mm. Weight: 1.76g.
