A complete flint blunted Scraper of Neolithic to Bronze Age date (3450-800 BC). The lithic is sub-rectangular in shape and cross-section. Half of the lithic is dark grey in colour and the other half is light grey. The dorsal side has obvious evidence of retouch on one side and a large negative scar that makes it easier to handle in one hand.
