# HARNESS PENDANT

An incomplete copper-alloy harness pendant of medieval date, AD 1200 - 1400. The pendant is shield shaped with the remains of an integral suspension loop projecting centrally from the upper edge. The loop is broken and worn. The pendant is decorated with a chequerboard design (Checky / Chequey) on the front surface. Half of the chequerboard retains blue enamel, the rest are empty.

The metal has a dark green patina and is worn. The pendant is 37.9mm long, 23.1mm wide, 2.9mm thick and weighs 7.2g.

Harness pendants are generally dated from the twelfth to the fourteenth century, with enamelled and heraldic types predominating in the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries (Griffiths 1995, p.62).
