Minister's Foreword


It is a great pleasure to introduce this year's Treasure Act 1996 Annual Report, which gives an overview of how the Treasure Act operated in England, Wales and Northern Ireland in 2018.

The Treasure Act relies on the time and expertise of many people across the country, including Finds Liaison Officers, funding partners and museum teams, who all deserve huge thanks for their hard work and contributions to the process. Finders and landowners are also at the heart of the Treasure Act and it's brilliant to see 76 finders and landowners who donated their finds in 2018.

I'd like to thank the Treasure Registry at the British Museum, the Amgueddfa Cymru/National Museum of Wales and the Department of Environment and Ulster Museum in Northern Ireland for their continued work to support the delivery of the Treasure Act across the UK. The Treasure Valuation Committee has also provided more expert advice this year, and I welcome their new chair, Roger Bland, who brings his formidable knowledge and expertise to the role.

2018 was notable for three rare finds that cast light on some of the earliest recorded history of these islands. The Iron Age chariot find in Wales and the Bronze Age bulla and sleeve fastenings found in England and Northern Ireland respectively, demonstrate the importance of the treasure process in extending our knowledge of the past and ensuring that important finds are available for the public to see and learn from.

We recently published the next steps following the consultation on the Treasure Act 1996. I hope everyone interested in treasure will engage with our ongoing work, building on past successes to make the Treasure Act 1996 even more effective.

Introduction

Under the Treasure Act 1996, finders have a legal obligation to report all finds of potential Treasure. For a summary see <https://finds.org.uk/treasure> or the leaflet *Advice for Finders of Archaeological Objects, Including Treasure*.

The Act allows a museum to acquire Treasure finds for public benefit. If this happens, a reward is paid, which is (normally) shared equally between the finder and landowner, though the interested parties may wish to waive their rewards, enabling museums to acquire such finds at no or reduced cost. Rewards are fixed at the market value of the find, determined by the Secretary of State on the advice of an independent panel of experts known as the Treasure Valuation Committee.

1,094 finds were reported Treasure in 2018, bringing the total number of Treasure finds reported to more than 15,000 since the commencement of the Act. In 2018 these cases consisted of over 20,906 individual artefacts, which make up a portion of the archaeological items found in England and Wales which are recorded with the Portable Antiquities Scheme; in 2018 there were 69,687 objects recorded with the Scheme. This data is published on its online database at *finds.org.uk*. The Scheme and its network of local archaeologists – experts in recording small finds, known as Finds Liaison Officers – play an important role in the operation of the Treasure Act, advising finders of their legal obligations, providing advice on the process and writing reports on potential Treasure finds for coroners.

Organisation

The administration of the Treasure Act is undertaken by the British Museum, which employs a Senior Treasure Registrar and four Treasure Registrars, one of whom is part-time. This work involves the preparation of Treasure cases for inquest (at a Coroner's Court), the handling of disclaimed cases, acting as the secretariat of the Treasure Valuation Committee, and the payment of rewards to finders/landowners. In Wales, Amgueddfa Cymru – National Museum Wales carries out the liaison with finders and coroners and in Northern Ireland this is done by the National Museum of Northern Ireland.

Treasure Valuation Committee

The Committee's terms of reference are detailed in the *Treasure Act 1996 Code of Practice*. In short, it is tasked to recommend to the Secretary of State the value of Treasure finds, to recommend abatements of rewards in the case of misbehaviour on the part of the interested parties, and to recommend an apportionment of the reward when there is a disagreement among the parties. The Committee is made up of independent experts appointed for their knowledge of the antiquities trade; its membership also includes someone to represent the interests of finders, a museums' representative, and an expert in cultural property law.

Membership of the Committee consists of Professor Roger Bland (Chair), Ms Gail Boyle, Ms Marian Campbell, Ms Harry Bain, Ms Hetty Gleave, Dr Megan Gooch, Mr Christopher Martin and Ms Lucinda Orr.

Impact of COVID-19

Whilst the target time for the completion of Treasure cases is one year from the time of reporting, the large number of items reported and the complexity and size of many of these cases means that they often take longer to process. Many cases were still in process when the COVID-19 pandemic caused the first national lockdown in March 2020 and subsequent measures were put in place to limit the spread of the virus. The British Museum was shut to all but essential workers and most British Museum staff were furloughed for the summer and autumn months of 2020, and many local and regional museums were operating with much reduced staff. The Treasure Valuation Committee was only able to carry out three (from seven) of its scheduled meetings. This meant, for the purposes of this report, that many Treasure cases reported in 2018 which would otherwise have been resolved in 2020, were further delayed. This can be seen in the analysis of Treasure finds, later in this report.

Treasure cases 2018

Number of Treasure cases and geographic distribution

The number of Treasure cases reported in 2018 was 1,094 (Table A). This is a slight decrease from the previous year, though such fluctuations are normal and often the result of vacancies in FLO posts throughout the year.

The high level of the reporting of Treasure reflects a wider understanding on the part of finders of their obligations under the Treasure Act, through the education and outreach work of the Portable Antiquities Scheme and its Finds Liaison Officers.

Analysis of Treasure finds by Geographical area

Table B illustrates the geographic distribution of Treasure finds. The overwhelming majority of finds reported under the Treasure Act come from England, with the eastern half of the country seeing the lions share. Norfolk, as usual, had the largest number with 103 cases. Following closely behind was Lincolnshire, with 87 cases – though it should be noted that 18 of those cases were small individual pieces of metal-working debris from the Torksey area. Suffolk and Hampshire both reported 68 cases of Treasure. In more northerly climes, North Yorkshire and the East Riding of Yorkshire combined for a total of 84 cases.

The number of Treasure cases reported from Wales (20) was lower than in any of the past five years, but Northern Ireland saw the largest number of cases (6) reported in any year since the commencement of the Act. All but one of these was from County Down, which has historically been the most productive area. Overall of course finds from Northern Ireland make up a tiny proportion of all Treasure finds, which is partially explained by the fact that unlicensed searching for antiquities with a metal detector is not permitted there.

Analysis of Treasure finds by period, type and disposition

Table C provides the dispositional outcome of Treasure cases according to period and type.

The first thing to note is that the exceptional circumstances around the COVID-19 pandemic meant that a significantly large number of cases (123) had unknown dispositions at the time of report writing. In 2017 that number was 88, itself a higher figure than the previous year. Any conclusions made about the data need to take this into account.

The percentage of cases being acquired by museums (including both donations and cases where the museum had to pay) was remarkably consistent with the rate from 2017 – 31.8% to 31.5%

There is a public cost to the administration of the Treasure Act, especially in organising the valuation and reward payments. The Code of Practice requires that all finds valued by the Treasure Valuation Committee be seen and reported on by a member of the antiquities trade, whose fees must be included. Accordingly, museums have been reminded that they should only express interest in acquiring finds if they have a serious and realistic chance to complete the acquisition.

A steady rate of acquisition indicates that museums with restricted budgets are making effective use of the opportunities for fundraising available to them; from the national funding bodies listed above to local funders and by holding events to raise money.

Treasure finds are Crown property. Slightly more than half (53%) of all Treasure cases were disclaimed by the Crown and returned to the finder or landowner, while another 4% were found to fall outside the definition of Treasure after they are reported. As with previous years, coin cases tend to be acquired by museums at a higher rate than object cases (44% compared to 30%), and as a general observation, the older an object or coin, the more likely it is to be acquired by museums.

Donations

The generosity of those interested parties who waive their rewards is essential in ensuring that a high number of finds end up in public collections. The DCMS, national museums and the Portable Antiquities Scheme maintain a policy of proactive encouragement of interested parties to consider waiving their right to a reward.

At the time of report writing, of the cases reported in 2018 which are being acquired, 22% (76) have seen one or more interested parties waive their right to a reward. This will no doubt increase as more cases are declared Treasure at inquest and valued – most donations come after at least a provisional valuation of the case has been carried out, as it is from that point that interested parties appreciate the market value of the find.

A number of these were for notable artefacts. Rick Walker and the landowner both waived their reward for a Bronze Age copper-alloy hoard from Langford, Essex (2018 T456) so that it could go to Chelmsford Museum at no cost. The finder of a Medieval silver-gilt plaque from Normanby, North Yorkshire (2018 T46), featuring the lamb of God in front of a cross and pennant, declined a reward of £175 to enable York Museums Trust to acquire the piece. The anonymous landowner where the silver-gilt posy ring from Nash, Buckinghamshire (2018 T307) was found gave up a reward of £325 to allow the ring to be acquired more easily by Bucks County Museum.

Many finders and landowners waived their right to a reward prior to an inquest being held, before the cases were valued. This not only helped the acquiring museums, but also saved public money by not requiring the system to pay for provisional valuations from a member of the trade.

Table D gives the method of discovery of finds reported as Treasure in 2018. As in previous years, metal-detecting accounts for the vast majority of Treasure cases reported in England, Wales and Northern Ireland (96.07%), the same ratio as last year. A much smaller portion of finds originate from archaeological digs (2.65%) and other means. Most of the Treasure finds from professional excavations will remain with the rest of the material in the site archive, though landowners are eligible to claim rewards under the Treasure Act.

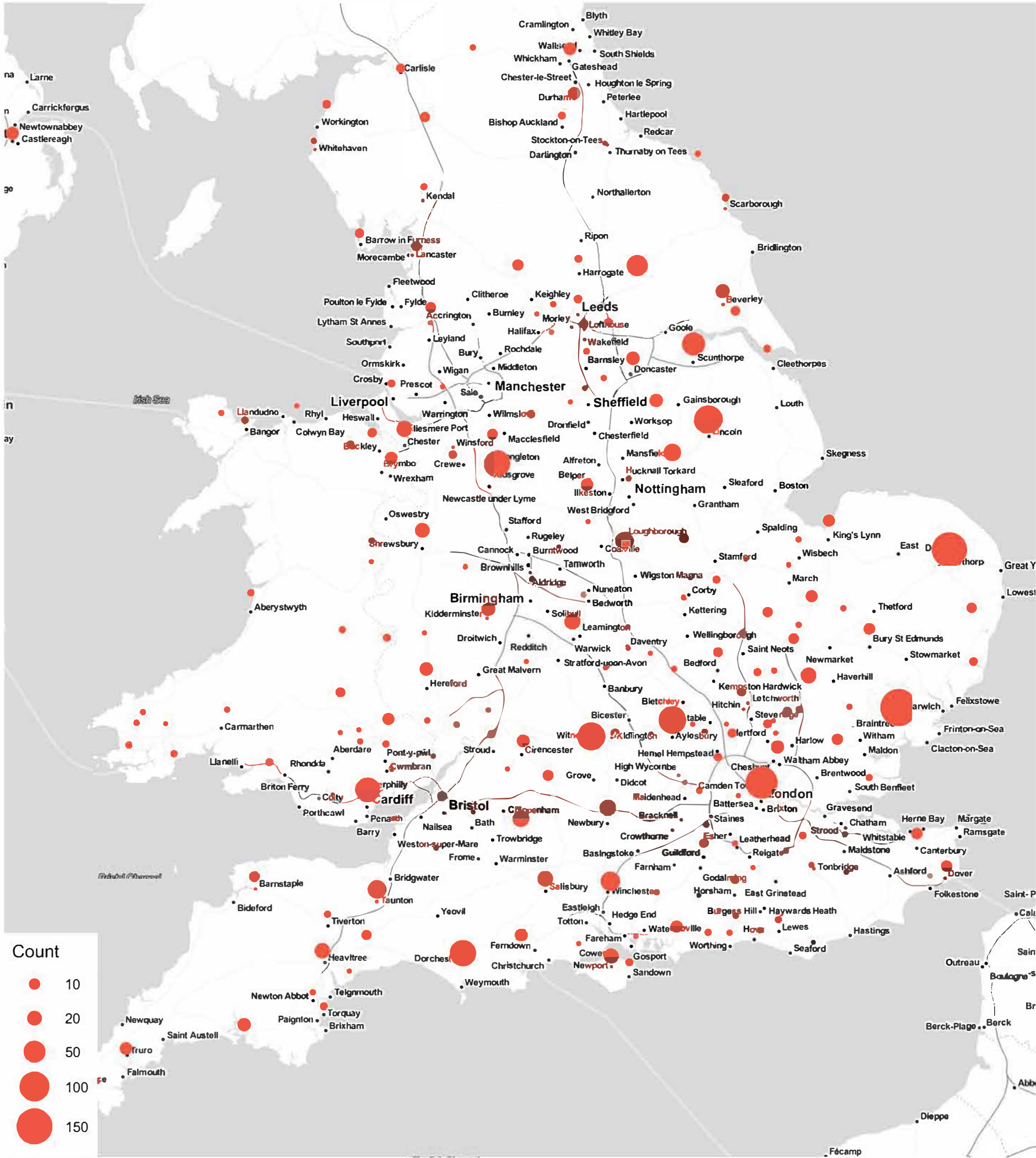

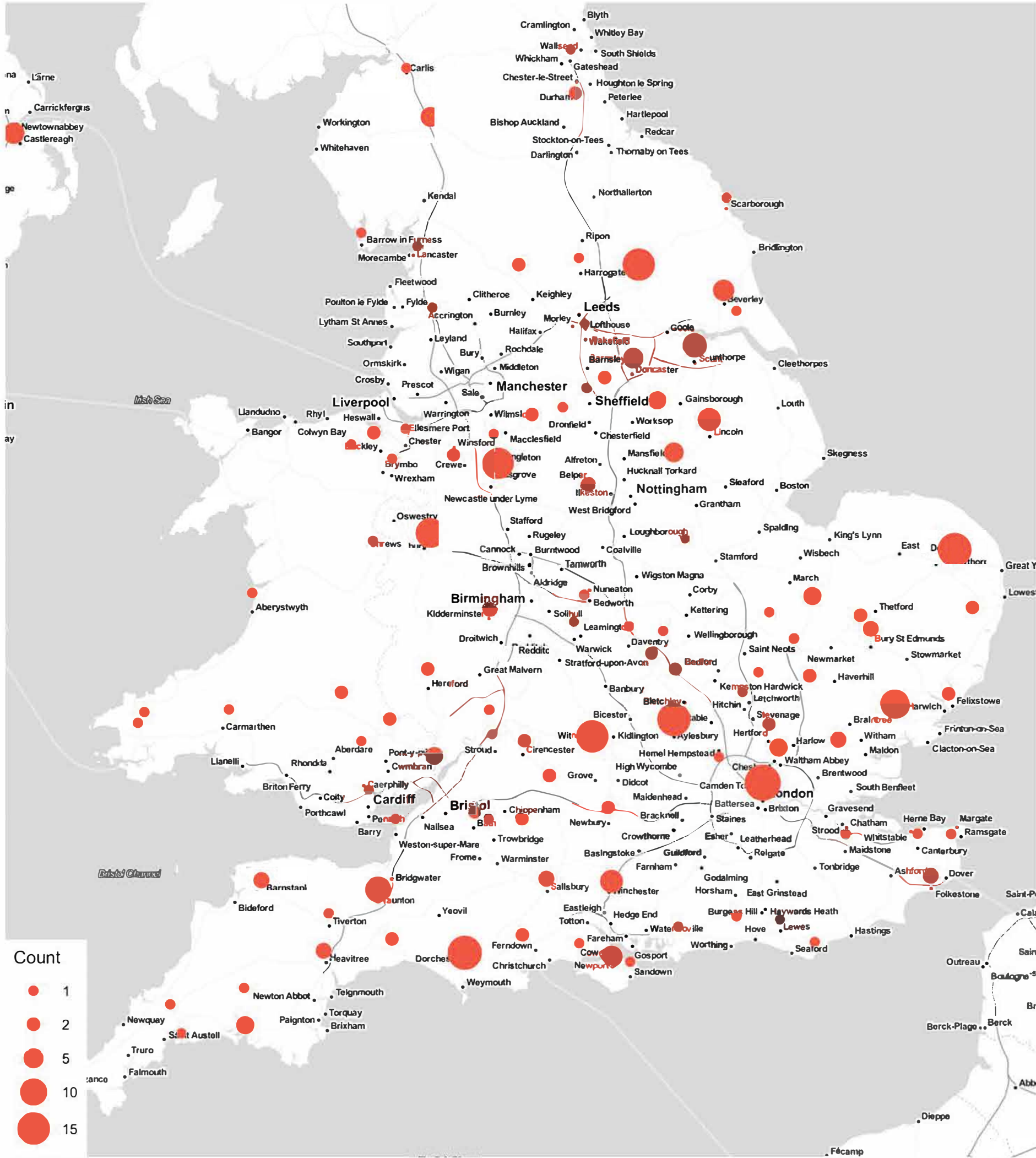
An important goal of the Treasure Act is to ensure that the public benefits from these finds by allowing them to be passed to relevant museums. The Treasure Act provides a reliable and secure mechanism for museum acquisition, as the objects all have clear, established provenances and the museums do not have to negotiate with private dealers or pay auction fees. Table E lists all of the museums, museum services or archaeological archives across the country acquiring Treasure reported in the years 2012 – 2018, along with the number of cases they have acquired. Over the course of this seven-year period, 223 different bodies have acquired Treasure. For cases reported in 2018, 108 institutions acquired or are in the process of acquiring finds. The large majority are acquired by local (i.e. non-national) museums, 321 of 347 cases in 2018, or 93%. Aside from the British Museum, the largest number of cases were acquired by Buckinghamshire County Museum in 2018 – 16 – followed closely by Dorset County Museum and Norwich Castle Museum. In most instances, the national museum will act as the back-up and acquire important finds only if the local museum is unable to. In Wales, Amgueddfa Cymru/National Museum Wales has traditionally acquired the majority of finds reported, but thanks to support from its HLF funded *Saving Treasures; Telling Stories* project, many more museums around the country were enabled to acquire Treasure from their local area.

The maps on the following page shows all of the museums that have acquired Treasure in the period 2012-2018, and just those acquired in 2018. The larger the dots, the more cases that museum has acquired. As is perhaps expected, museums in East Anglia like Norwich Castle Museum and Colchester & Ipswich Museums Service acquire many cases but other museums in areas outside of the South East and East Anglia also show themselves to be major acquirers of Treasure. These include the Potteries Museum & Art Gallery in Stoke-on-Trent, North Lincolnshire Museum, Oxfordshire Museums and the York Museums Trust. The maps show the wide geographic spread of museums acquiring Treasure finds. (Maps were kindly produced by Robin Edwards.)

Enforcement

It is the aim of the Treasure Act to encourage people to report finds rather than pursue prosecutions. This is reflected in the fact that finders have 14 days to report Treasure from when they first know or have reason to believe the item they have found is potential Treasure: unique in English law. However, that is not to say finders who fail to report Treasure will not be prosecuted.

The British Museum works closely with relevant colleagues in local police forces, HM Revenue & Customs, and the Arts Council England (ACE) Export Licensing Unit, as well as the Metropolitan Police Service's Art & Antiques Unit and the Alliance to Reduce Heritage Crime. The Portable Antiquities Scheme also has a representative on the National Police Chief Council's Heritage and Cultural Property Crime Working Group.

The British Museum has a memorandum of understanding with eBay allowing it to question vendors of items of potential unreported Treasure. In 2018, three cases were logged and made available to the police.

Since September 2007, the Head of the Portable Antiquities Scheme has been an Expert Adviser for export licensing applications of metal-detected finds. In several cases exporters of unreported potential Treasure were asked to report these items in accordance with the Treasure Act.

The Treasure Valuation Committee, in addition to recommending to the Secretary of State the value of finds of Treasure, also recommends abatements of rewards to interested parties when they are deemed to have behaved poorly in the course of making and reporting the Treasure find. The circumstances for which a reward may be abated are listed in paragraph 79 of the Treasure Act Code of Practice. Since 2007, there have been 24 cases where the Committee has abated a reward; the most common offenses are failure to seek permission prior to searching, failure to report finds in a timely manner or as directed by the Coroner, and deliberately or recklessly damaging artefacts. In the last year the Committee has recommended an abatement of 90% of the finder's share of a reward for an Early Medieval gold setting (case 2018 T252), after the finder failed to hand over the piece for more than a year.

The data in Table F reflects the information available as of November 2020. There are a number of cases that are still undergoing the valuation process where the final valuation is still pending. Some cases that are acquired by museums are not valued at all, because the interested parties waive their right to a reward before the case reaches that stage.

The highest valued individual case in 2018 was 2018 T343, a Bronze Age gold bulla pendant from the Shropshire Marches, valued at £250,000. This was followed by an Iron Age chariot burial assemblage from Pembrokeshire, Wales (18.04) acquired by Amgueddfa Cymru/National Museum Wales for £45,000. The next highest valuation for a case that was acquired was for a Bronze Age gold sleeve

fastener from near Newtownards, Co. Down, which was acquired by the National Museums Northern Ireland for £15,000. The majority of cases with agreed valuations were valued at much lower figures, and the median value for all 175 cases with agreed figures was £180 - £40 less than cases from 2017 and £90 less than those reported in 2016.

The Treasure Valuation Committee saw 427 cases in the calendar year 2018, 43 more cases than it viewed in 2017. Of these cases, 20 were being reconsidered because one of the interested parties had challenged a previous recommendation by the Committee (compared to 31 such cases in the previous year). 18 of these challenges came from finders, one from a landowner and one from an acquiring museum. This seems to suggest that over 90% of the Committee recommendations are agreed by interested parties.
